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Responsibilities of Campus

Counselor

- Keep an updated list of all approved courses.
- Must stay aware of all changes and adjustments to the eligibility process.
- Must have a working relationship with parents, students, and coaches.
- Send transcripts after six and eight semesters
- Update list of NCAA courses annually
- Guidance

Coach

- Update and send out HUDL videos every 3 weeks to all colleges
- Check Student Athletes grades 2 x per week
- Identify College Athletes
- Must have a working relationship with parents, students, and counselor.
- Study colleges to find specific positional needs for upcoming recruiting classes
- Must stay aware of all changes and adjustments to the eligibility process.

Role Of The Student

- Role of the Student
 - Contact Counselor in reference to the students' interests
 - Registration and associated tasks
 - Responsible for academic progress & achievement
 - Generate quality film in designated sport
 - Speak with Coaches in reference to the students' interest
 - Must have a working relationship with parents, counselor, and coaches.
 - Make sure the student's name is in their social media handles
